Youth Rugby operates as a seven-week season on Sunday mornings, starting April 19 at Parkinson Rec Fields. The program boasts a low enrollment fee and family time commitment, while continuing to grow in popularity each year. Most of our families are new to the sport. The program introduces the fundamental movement skills associated with the sport of rugby in a fun, game-based format within the rugby community. All registered participants and coaches receive a t-shirt and complimentary BBQ at the conclusion of the season. It is anticipated that the 2020 season will be the first year that space may be limited.



MINI RUGBY (Born 2013 - 2016)

1 hour and 15 minute sessions, Sunday mornings.

YOUTH TOUCH SEVENS (Born 2007 - 2012)

2 hour sessions, Sunday mornings.
